Recognizing that all children develop at their own pace, there is a session for preschoolers (**ages 4-6**) and a "One More Time" session for **3rd-4th graders**. Programming is planned by age and allows for plenty of one-on-one and exploration time.

**Tenderfoot** is for young, overnight campers. This 4-day, 3-night camp introduces campers to all the fun activities at camp: swimming, boating, archery, crawfishing, arts & crafts, and an early morning favorite—the polar bear swim. This is a great experience for campers who are not ready to take on a full week but want to experience cabin life for the first time! **Grades 2-3**
